

# “Devil Dogs on Ice”



## Keflavik, Iceland — July 31st, 1941

On July 7th, the United States Marine Corps landed troops on Iceland to augment British forces currently deployed on the island. The Allies had invaded Iceland to deter any German designs on the island. And German plans under the codename “Fall Ikarus” were indeed already in motion. Determined to extend German air and naval power into the North Atlantic, Admiral Raeder had converted captured Icelandic fishing trawlers into German troop ships. With large German manpower reserves serving in Russia, Raeder was allotted newly minted Norwegian Volunteers of the Nordland Regiment for the operation. Additionally, a unit of Brandenburg Commandos would be landed on the island by U-Boat. Their mission was to secure the airfield at Keflavik in order for squadrons of FW-200’s to land the 2. Gebirgs Division and begin a general invasion of Iceland. But there was one problem for the German plan. Having been alerted to the possibility of a German invasion, forward elements of the 6th Marines led by 1st Lt. Donovan were hurrying to Keflavik to throw the Germans back into the sea. Once again, the Germans would face the fury of the Devil Dogs of the United States Marines.

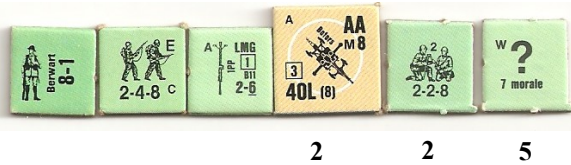

### Special Rules/Notes:

1. EC are Dry with Heavy wind from the North.
2. The American 9-2 represents Lt. Donovan. All Marine Units with Lt. Donovan are marked as Fanatic for the duration of the game for as long as they are stacked with him.
3. Beginning on Turn 3—the German Brandenburger units are marked with ammo shortage for the duration of the game.
4. The American 4-4-7 are considered US Marines. The 4-4-7 represents the fact that they are equipped with bolt action Springfield Rifles.
5. The US forces utilize British equipment without penalty.
6. All Trees and Orchards hexes are in fact Brush. There are no trees.

**Aftermath:** The German assault on the airfield met determined resistance from Icelandic defense forces manning Bofors guns. The arrival of Nordland gave the German attack the additional weight needed to overcome the Icelandic defenders, but the delay would be costly. Before the Germans could secure the airfield, they found themselves in a chaotic close quarters battle with the men of the US 6th Marines. In the desperate battle that followed, the untested men of Nordland were pushed back until surrender was their only option. And receiving no all clear signal from Keflavik, the FW-200 Squadrons returned to Oslo. The German invasion of Iceland was over.
