

“The Professor’s House”



Stalingrad, Russia — October 14th, 1942

On October 14th, the German launched their offensive the northern factory district of Stalingrad. The assault was preceded by a massive air and artillery bombardment. The focus of the initial effort would be against the 37th Guards Rifle Division which was defending worker housing to the south of the Tractor Factory. The German Kampfgruppe Jaenecke led the assault and hit the Russians hard as they tried to recover from the devastating bombardment.

Board Configuration: (Deluxe ASL Board i)



Only Hex Rows G-O are in play.

VICTORY CONDITIONS: The German Player wins immediately by controlling 6 or more of the 8 building hexes of the Professors House or at game end if the Germans control all other stone buildings and at least one building hex of the Professors House. Any other result is a Russian victory.

Elements 2nd Batttalion, 109th Guards Rifle Regiment (ELR 3) (SAN 4) (Set up: on in building or rubble locations only on or east of Hex Row K)



Hvy. Mortar Platoon (ELR 3) (Set up: Broken and with Mortars malfunctioned with one mortar and crew per Trench Hex)



Elements of Kampfgruppe Jaenecke (ELR 4) (SAN 3) (Set up: enter Turn 1 on the west edge)



Special Rules/Notes:

- EC are moderate with no wind.
- Kindling is N.A.
- OVERLAYS: place Rubble Counters in the following hexes: N1, M2, M5, L1, L2, L4, K2, K5, J1, I1, I3, H3, G1, G2, and G5. Place Overlay dx5 on N4-M4.
- Place a Trench in Hexes J2, K3, & K4.
- Place Shell Holes (B2.1) in Hexes O5, Overlay M4, N3 & N4.
- Building J3 is the “Professors House” and has 3 Upper levels. Units on Levels 2 and 3 may not gain concealment to units with LOS through Hex I3.
- The Russians have Molotov’s. (A22.6)
- Russian Units in the Professors House have an ELR of 5.
- Encirclement is N.A. for Russian Units in the Professors House.
- Commissars (A25.22) are N.A.

Aftermath: Kampfgruppe Jaenecke hit the area defended by Podpolkovnik Fedor S. Omelchenko’s 109th Guards Rifle Regiment. Soon, Omelchenko’s 2nd Battalion was isolated in the worker’s settlement and the Germans were advancing quickly on the Professors House where Omelchenko’s headquarters was located. Three Mark III’s of the 14th Panzer Division led the assault against Omelchenko’s headquarters. A 120mm Mortar Section had been decimated in front of the Professors House. The Panzers found it hard going with rubble and the stout defense of the Russians using Molotov’s an Anti-Tank Rifles. Infantry from the German 305th Infantry Division joined the attack and succeeded in taking the lower level of the Professors House. But a fierce counter-attack would throw them out and the Germans would bypass the building.
